Dennison Rotary Club

The Rotary Club of Dennison was chartered on July 9, 1924. The club has provided continuous service to the area since that time and continues to meet at the Dennison Presbyterian Church, which is the same location that the club has met in the 87 years of its existence.

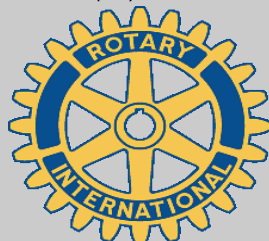
Many ask "what is Rotary"? A short answer is that Rotary is the worlds first service club made up of business and professional persons united worldwide to provide humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations and help build goodwill and peace in the world. Rotary Club members are volunteers who work locally, regionally, and internationally to combat hunger and thirst, improve health and sanitation, provide education and job training, promote peace, eradicate polio and improve communities under the motto Service Above Self.

The Name of Rotary was derived by the early practice of rotating meetings among the offices of its members. Today, there are more than 1.2 million Rotary members serving more than 30,000 clubs world-wide. Rotary traces its beginning back to Chicago in February of 1905 when Founder, Lawyer, Paul Harris along with three other men agreed that they could combine business with pleasure.

The Dennison Club has been involved in many projects to better the life of the people of the Twin Cities and surrounding areas. The club prides itself with the blood profile program sponsored through the Twin City Hospital twice each year. Many lives have been saved with this program by detecting health issues through a simple blood test which is affordably priced. More than 2200 people participate each year. Proceeds from the blood profile benefit many community projects such as the development of Heritage Park in Dennison, the new electronic bill-board near McCauley Drive, Uhrichsville and Dennison Park improvement projects, equipment purchases and improvements at Twin City Hospital, flood relief for local residents who were victims of three different floods and numerous other projects and sponsorships. The club also was responsible for building the helipad at Twin City Hospital which was constructed prior to offering the blood profile.

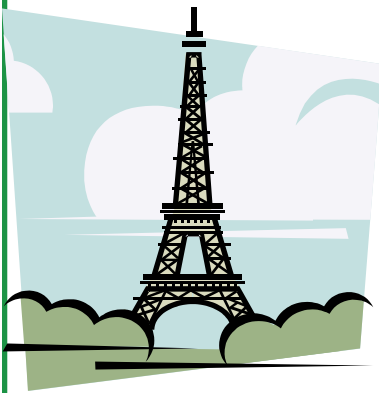

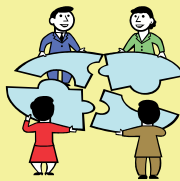
Just a reminder that the Dennison Depot's Annual Spring Ball is this Saturday April 2nd. It's not too late to join us.

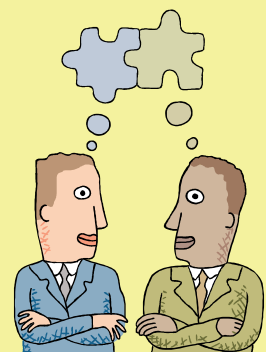

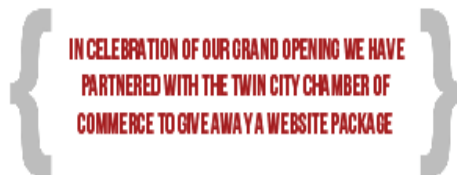

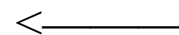
