July 2011 Chamber Connection Spotlight

A Brief History of the Uhrichsville First United Methodist Church

The Uhrichsville First United Methodist Church is celebrating 175 years in 2011!

On July 5, 1836 a meeting was held in the home of Mr. & Mrs. John Myers in Waterford (now Uhrichsville), where the “Methodist Episcopal Society” was formally organized. There were 22 Charter Members. They continued meeting in homes, the old schoolhouse, and “in the grove of Beech and Sugar maples behind Collier’s Hardware Store,” until a new church “meetinghouse” was built in 1840 on the northeast corner of N. Main & E. 4th Streets. Almost immediately, a Sunday School program was started and a parsonage was built in 1841 near where N. Dawson St. & Eastport Ave. now intersect.

The community and our congregation continued to grow over the years and we were soon in need of a larger building. Our current church building & parsonage were completed in 1870 - with bricks “burned” on site. The original steeple was 145 feet high. The old building continued to be used for a number of years as a community gathering place known as “Central Hall.”

On Palm Sunday, March 31, 1958, ground was broken for a new educational building. The cornerstone of our current Fellowship Hall was laid June 9, 1958 and was opened for use June 7, 1959.

Saturday, September 17, 2011 – Block Party/Open House/Concert – From 4:00pm to 6:00pm the community is invited for free hot dogs, etc. and to tour our church and a display of our archives. At 6:00pm there will be an outdoor concert by the Shiloh Mountain Trio in our back lot on 3rd Street. Bring a chair or blanket. (In case of inclement weather, all activities will be moved inside the church.)

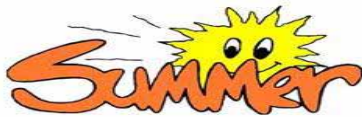

The Dennison Rotary Club invites you to sign up for the 2011 PARADE OF FLAGS - a project to help communities fly the red, white and blue on our five flag-waving holidays: Memorial Day, Flag Day, Independence Day, Labor Day and Veterans' Day.

Last year we installed over fifty flags; our goal this year is to triple that amount (with the hope that the number will grow each year)!

The Rotary Club will place a 3' x 5' flag in your front yard for each of the five holiday weekends and pick it up again after the weekend. A plastic pipe will be buried in your front lawn - flush with the ground (below mowing level), to hold the flagstaff. A plastic cap will cover the pipe when not in use. Rotary will provide and install the pipe and cap, provide the flag, store it properly, and deliver and pick it up for each of the holidays. The flag and staff will remain the property of the Dennison Rotary Club.

**HARCATUS Family Support
Summer Cooling Program opens July 5th.**

DENNISON, Ohio -- HARCATUS Tri-County CAO Family Support Centers

The HARCATUS Tri-County Summer Cooling Assistance Program, designed to assist income eligible households with a member who is 60 years of age and older or has physician documentation of an illness that is aggravated by extreme heat, is opening on July 5th and will close on August 31st, or earlier if funds are exhausted.

HARCATUS Family Support Centers will be scheduling appointments for assistance beginning June 27th. The Summer Cooling Program may assist with one payment on an electric bill, up to \$175; a disconnect notice is not required. All offices will provide counseling on payment plan options, even if the applicant does not qualify for a Summer Cooling benefit.

Income eligibility is based on 200% of the 2011 Federal Poverty Guidelines. The guidelines begin with a maximum of \$21,780 gross income for a one-person household during the past 12 months; add \$7,640 for each additional household member. All applicants are required to provide documentation of total gross household income for either the 3 months or 12 months prior to the date of application and proof of United States Citizenship or Alien Status. Social security numbers, birth dates, proof of how the home is heated, and the most recent electric bill must be supplied. All household members who are 18 years of age or older that do not have an income must provide something in writing that explains their situation. Written verification must be submitted for anyone living in the household who is claiming permanent and total disability or an illness that is aggravated by extreme heat. HARCATUS Family Support Center personnel have copies available of a standard form for Physician verification of the qualifying illness. Staff members are not permitted to make telephone calls or access information on old agency paper files to verify income or other household information.

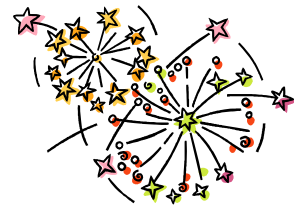

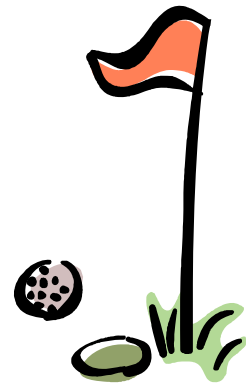
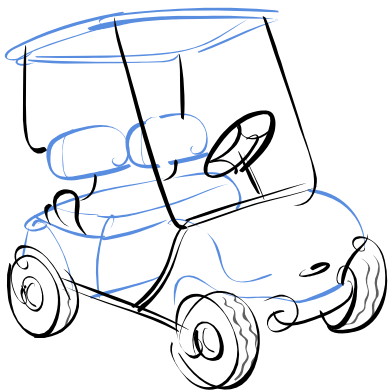
