The store will be open Monday through Friday from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Saturday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. and closed Sundays.

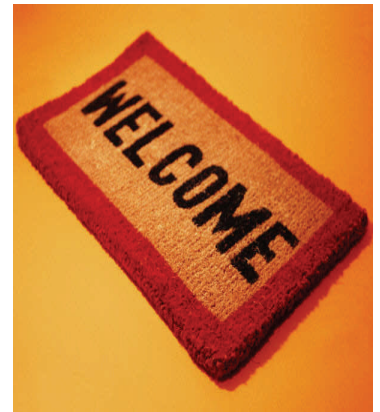
The shop will serve fruit and vegetable juices, smoothies, fruit salads, summer and winter soups, roasted nuts and baked goods.
