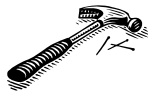

Beatty's is the sole provider of the E3 Wall System.

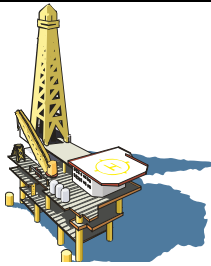
