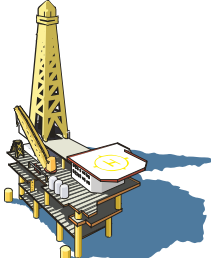

Schoenbrunn Hosts 18th Century Weekend in the Village

The popular Colonial Trade Fair will return to Schoenbrunn Village for its third year this October. Over the third weekend, Saturday 15th and Sunday 16th, the Village will bustle with vendors and demonstrators from 1750-1789. Sample, view, and purchase wares from horners, potters, weavers, coopers, blacksmiths, the apothecary, revolutionary war characters, natives and colonial doctor.... to name only a few.

Walking into the Schoenbrunn Village, visitors will be taken to the past with an exciting twist to the Moravian Mission Settlement. The streets will be lined with reenactors covering the end of the 18th century. Cabins and tents will be filled with the trades from the time, while vendors and demonstrators work on their crafts. Visitors will not only be able to enjoy period participants work, but purchase many of the wares from costumes, pottery, and weaving.

Demonstrators will share the secrets to the 18th Century medical field. Ever wonder how an amputation was performed? Visit the apothecary to learn the techniques of medicine and even discover the creatures they may have used to help them.

Along with period medical displays, the weekend will be filled with other period exhibitions. Musket demonstrations will be given daily, showing how settlers were surviving on the Ohio Frontier and during the American Revolution. New this year, an after hours lantern tour will close the day on Saturday the 15th from 7pm- 10pm along with a colonial tavern style dinner, reservations required.

Bring the entire family to an event that will not only be fun but educational. Watch as children learn as they search through the cabins set-up with the vendor's ware, but take the time for adults to engage in conversation with the reenactors. Families will also be able to enjoy \$5.00 make and take crafts given in the Church on Saturday and Sunday.

The Trade Fair will also see the Tavern Dinner return, Saturday evening at 7:00pm with the chance to enjoy a meal set to the tunes of the 18th century in our recreated tavern located in the Schoenbrunn Meeting House. Enjoy a meal by fireside and candlelight under the towering roof. Reservations are required with tickets at \$25.00 a person, ticket prices also include admission to the Colonial Trade Fair and Lantern Tour.

Enjoy a snack outside of the Village as families can spend time visiting the Village gift shop with items for all ages and interests and in the surrounding areas are visitors able to sample colonial cuisine. Vendors will also be set-up inside and outside of the village.
